## Floor Loom Weaving

This week-long seminar is designed for the beginning weaver who wishes to learn the basic skills of floor loom weaving. This class can also accommodate weavers with some experience who are looking for a refresher class.

Spend two days learning to plan and calculate materials, winding a warp, filling bobbins, and dressing the loom. The remaining time will be spent weaving and finishing. Students may take the class as many times as they wish. Special projects can be explored if approved by the instructor.

## Objectives:

The student will learn to:

- 1. Plan and calculate materials for a weaving.
- 2. Wind a warp and fill bobbins.
- 3. Dress (put warp on) a loom.

- 4. Weave plain weave and twill samples.
- 5. Weave three towels.
- 6. Finish woven samples and towels for use.

## Notes:

- 1) An additional \$20 materials fee will be due the first day of class.
- 2) Students may bring a bag lunch or go for food.
