**COUNT FOUR** 

CHARLES BAKER, CLERK SUPERIOR-STATE COURT

AND THE GRAND JURORS, aforesaid, in the name and on behalf of the citizens of Georgia, charge and accuse BILLY D. NICELY with the offense of AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, for that the said accused in the County of Hall and the State of Georgia on the 30TH DAY OF MARCH, 2009, did assault another, to-wit: Tayore Wright, a child under the age of eighteen (18), with an object, instrument and device, the exact type of which is unknown to the Grand Jury, which, when used offensively against said child, actually did result in serious bodily injury, by inflicting injuries causing cranial cerebral trauma, in violation of O.C.G.A. § 16-5-21(a)(2), contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.
