AND THE GRAND JURORS, aforesaid, in the name and on behalf of the citizens of Georgia, charge and accuse **WILLIAM RICHARD GABLE** with the offense of **AGGRAVATED ASSAULT**, for that the said accused in the County of Hall and the State of Georgia on the **1ST DAY OF MAY, 2009**, did assault another, to-wit: Steven Paul Brookshire, with a tree limb, an object which, when used offensively against a person actually does result in serious bodily injury, by striking Steven Paul Brookshire on the neck with said tree limb, in violation of O.C.G.A. § 16-5-21(a)(2), contrary to the laws of said State, the good order, peace and dignity thereof.
