Re: North Hall Library Funding

Dear Governor Perdue:

The Hall County Board of Commissioners is requesting the consideration of your office in assisting the Hall County Library Board and Hall County Commission with the partial funding of our North Hall Library construction project.

The County has purchased property within the Town of Clermont near Highway 129 to build a community library at that site to serve residents living in the North Hall County. The building is envisioned to be approximately 15,000 square feet and will offer the latest technology and educational facilities to the residents. This facility will also provide meeting space and study areas and the library staff will conduct programs to assist in improving our resident's quality of life.
