On above date and time while performing a foot patrol on the square for the annual mule camp event, myself and Cpl. Champion were approached by Gaineville Jaycee (Michael Barron). Barron (a permittee representative for the Jaycees) advised us that a white male subject was campaigning with Ray Barnes signs inside their event. Barron stated that in the past there had been issues

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between both political parties, ultimately resulting in altercations. Barron stated that the Jaycees did not want any campaigning to take place at their event because it would take away from the purpose of the event. Barron advised that he would like for the subject to take his sign down or leave the event.

Myself and Cpl. Champion then made contact with Campaigner Larry Gibson. Cpl. Champion advised Gibson that the Jaycees requested he not campaign inside their event. Gibson replied that it was his "right" to campaign and that he would not take his sign down.

At this point I contacted Lt. Robertson to advise me on the specific guidelines of special event permits. I advised Lt. Robertson of the Jaycees request and of Gibson's response to the request.

Lt. Robertson was not familiar off hand of the particulars and advised he would research the city ordinances and permit regulations.

Gibson was allowed to stay on the square with his sign until we were able to determine the particulars of the ordinance and/or permit specifications. Approximately an hour and half later Barron contacted me and advised that Gibson was still at the event and was now

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disturbing sales at booths that were set up. Barron stated that he made contact with Gibson and ask that he leave, Gibson refused and walked away from Barron.

Aftering speaking with Barron, I contacted Lt Robertson and advised him of Barron's complaint. Lt Robertson ask that I meet with him on the square to make contact with Gibson.

Lt Robertson advised me that in the permit section of 6-7-103 it reads that no person shall participate in a special event and knowingly violate the permittee's regulations or conditions. Thus, then applies to criminal trespass once the violator refuses to comply with the permittee's request.

Permittee; representative Barron, simply ask that Gibson campaign outside the designated permit area or take down his sign.

Myself and Lt Robertson made contact with Gibson and explained to Gibson what the permit regulations stated and what the Jaycees requested. Gibson advised us that it was unconstitutional to make him leave and that we would have to take him to jail. Gibson stated to myself and Lt Robertson that he was not taking his sign down nor would he leave.

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With Gibson's refusal, I placed him under arrest and escorted him to my patrol car. Lt. Robertson assisted me by searching Gibson prior to placing him in my vehicle. Gibson was seat belted and transported to Hall Co Det. Ctr. where he was released to Ofc. Morgan in booking.

Due to the size of the campaign sign the jail refused to take possession of it. At the request of Gibson I contacted his brother E.L. Gibson to come pick the sign up. I met E.L. Gibson at the Public Safety Building where I signed over custody of the sign. E.L. Gibson signed to take possession of the sign. No further contact was made with Gibson.

I did return to the square and obtained written statements from Barron and a business owner that was disturbed by Gibson's actions. See attached.

Also placed into evidence is a DVD of the specific areas designated for the Mule Camp event.
